Travel Dates	Recommended Location	What to Expect
Sept 25 – Oct 4	North of Barre, VT; North of Woodstock, NH; North of Rang	High potential for peak in the "Far North".
Oct 5 – Oct 15	Central Vermont, NH Lakes Region, and Western MA.	The "Classic" window for many popular spots.
Late October	Southern MA, Connecticut, and Rhode Island.	Coastal beauty and "late" oaks/maples.
